Dear Parents,

National Scholarship Scheme is open now. Those who are eligible can apply online through NSP portal.

Eligibility criteria are as follows:

- This Scholarship is applicable to students who belong to the Christians (BC) or Muslim (BC) community.
- 2) Maximum of 2 Children from a family can avail of this facility.
- 3) Income of the parents should be less than one lakh.
- 4) Students from Gr. 1 to 9 can apply.

How to apply?

- 1) Visit a Browsing Centre, as it cannot be applied over the phone.
- 2) Browse https://scholarships.gov.in/
- 3) Click on New Registration
- 4) Verify all the conditions and click on continue
- 5) Fill up the 'Fresh' or 'Renewal' Registration for Academic Year 2022-23.
- 6) You will receive an OTP for your Aadhar registered mobile number.
- 7) Enter the OTP to close the application.
- 8) You will receive a User ID and Password to the Registered Mobile Number.
- 9) Click on 'Login to Apply'.
- 10) Enter your User Id and Password and take a printout of the application.
- 11) Submit your application copy to the school office along with the following documents.

Documents to be submitted in school (photocopies):

- 1) Applied Online Scholarship Application printout
- 2) 2 passport size photos of students (should be in formal school uniform)
